Pacific City/Woods Community Planning Advisory Committee

Minutes of the Meeting on March 30, 2010

6:30 pm – Kiawanda Senior Community Center, 34600 Cape Kiwanda Drive
Pacific City, Oregon

The meeting was called to order at 6:32 pm by Chair Thomas Donohue. Also in attendance were Robyn Lampa, Secretary, Rob Royster, Past Chair and Chair of the LUC, and Bud Miller, Secretary. Eight others were also in attendance.

This meeting was held to discuss Variance Request V-10-01(a). It asked for reducing the setback requirements on two sides of the existing structure in order to add a porch to the front. This would return the house to its original configuration. Following discussion of this topic at the CPAC Land Use Committee meeting on March 27, 2010, the committee unanimously passed a resolution urging the CPAC membership to support this Request.

After a review of the changes and some discussion, the CPAC members at this meeting voted on the following resolution:

“The PC/Woods CPAC accepts the LUC recommendation to support the Variance Request and submit this information to the Tillamook County Department of Community Development.”

The vote of the members was 9 in favor, 0 against, and 2 abstain.

There was a motion as follows:

“CPAC send a copy of the CPAC letter to the Department of Community Development in support of the Variance Request to the applicant.”

This was approved with 9 votes for, 0 against, and 2 astain.

Meeting was adjourned at 6:50 pm.
