2. Guest Speaker: Haley Lutz, Coordinator for the Nestucca, Neskowin, and Sand Lake Watersheds Council. “Progress and Challenges in Our Local Watersheds”
2017 Annual Report. Watersheds are local groups formed to address the watersheds and fish species in our area. They provide a forum for public participation and education regarding watershed enhancement and protection. They work with landowners to protect fish life. This year the NNSL Watersheds Council worked to replace the failing 9ft wide culvert on Boulder Creek. Replaced it with a 72ft span bridge. Will replace the next crossing up stream this summer and will then have completed opening up all of the boulder creek waterway. Working on Jewel Creek culverts. Replaced a 6ft culvert with a 35ft bridge and will do more on that creek in the near future. Have worked with many land owners to work on streamside planting. Also work with dairy farmers to put up cattle fences along waterways to keep vegetation growing along stream beds. Maintain new plantings for three years. Plant native species. Every other year they organize a large Nestucca bay clean up. Dorymen association help a lot with boats in that clean up. They work in Nestucca Valley School District and at Neskowin Valley School to teach about plant propagation and later use those plants in their streamside planting. Did a Dory Days event in 2017, a kids art event. Held four Science Pubs in 2017. The Science Pubs are usually held at the Pelican Pub and KCC. One coming up next month about river otters at the Pelican Pub. They apply for grants and seek outside funding for all their projects. \$850,000 was brought in to work in Tillamook County in 2017.
